## REPRESENTATIVE EXPERIENCE

**Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWP3)** – Perform monthly on-site inspections based on TCEQ SWP3 regulations. Assistance in drafting SWP3 plans at multiple sites; providing on-site information such as pictures of key-locations and updating site layouts.
